- There is a **Museum Walk-Through Guide** for the other students in class (a worksheet that corresponds to your project)

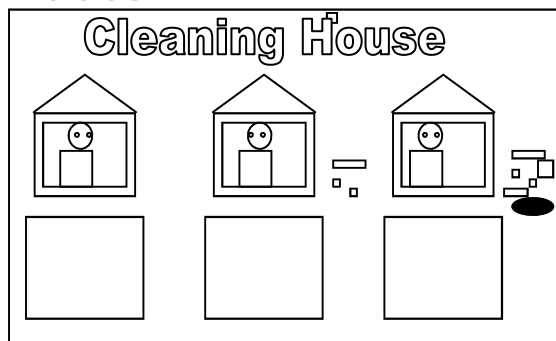
